Golf Tournament Fundraiser Held to Fight Drugs in Nevada

The Solutions Foundation to Partner with Fellow Non-profit Nevada State Friends for K-9

LAS VEGAS – June 8, 2009, The Solutions Foundation is teaming up with Nevada State Friends for K-9 for their second annual golf tournament to be held at Canyon Gate Country Club on Monday, June 15, 2009.

The golf tournament will begin with a trained K-9 demonstration provided by Nevada State Friends for K-9. The June 15 golf tournament will follow a scramble format. The cost for each individual player is \$150 with sponsorship levels ranging from \$250 to \$5000. There are approximately 30 sponsors and about 80 golfers participating. Contests will include a Closest to the Pin, Hole in One and Longest Drive competition. Each golfer will receive a goody bag as well as lunch sponsored by Health Plan of Nevada.

The main functions of The Foundation are to provide education, prevention, training regarding chemical dependency. To date, The Foundation has partnered with large scale community programs such as the Crystal Darkness and Opiate Awareness Campaigns to detour children from engaging in drug use. The Foundation has trained thousands of students and faculty on the dangers of opiates in over 20 schools this year. The Solutions Foundation currently provides recovery services to the Twelve Step Community by providing locations and volunteers to hold Twelve-Step meetings. The Solutions Foundation also holds monthly drug offender education courses referred to as SAAP for the Clark County School District. This course requires student offenders to participate with their parents in a 4 hour education course on the dangers of alcohol and drug abuse.

“Our hope is to help raise money for The Solutions Foundation so we can continue our efforts to help kids and families avoid substance abuse,” said David Marlon, president and founder of The Solutions Foundation. “We’ve been doing some wonderful things in the community and we hope to make an even bigger impact in the coming months.”

Nevada State Friends for K-9 is a nonprofit organization dedicated to assisting Nevada law enforcement in launching a police K-9 program for use in curbing the flow of drugs, particularly methamphetamine, into and through the state. This public-private partnership seeks funds to purchase and deploy 25 specially trained police dogs across the state for use by the Nevada Department of Public Safety in its campaign to reduce drug traffic and use in Nevada.

The next Solutions Foundation fundraising reception is scheduled for December 3, 2009.
